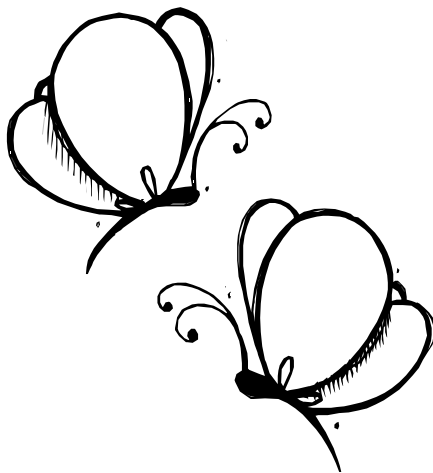

Note: Many of the "summer perennials" will continue to bloom until frost if dead flowers are regularly removed and the plant is not allowed to go to seed earlier in the season. A few of the early varieties, such as viola, may have second season of bloom if the fall is cool and the moisture supply is sufficient.
