Rabbits prefer a variety of plants, especially those that are young and tender. Listed are a few plants which have been said to repel rabbits. There is no solid research to back up this claim. It may be worth a try to edge your area with some of these plants.

Equally reliable results may be achieved by damage prevention and control methods.

- One of the best ways to protect a garden is to put up a fence.
- Chemical repellents discourage rabbit browsing.
- Reducing rabbits' habitat by removing brush piles, weed patches, dumps, stone piles, and other debris.
- Live trapping is an effective method for removing rabbits.
